





- 251 migrant women have been beneficiaries of the project. Through individual counselling or training.
- 67 entrepreneurship professionals or NGO workers have been trained to adapt their services according to the needs of women entrepreneurs.
- 1 policy recommendation guide with a total of 10 recommendations developed according to the project results and studies.
- 20 good practices have been identified in counselling or support services for migrant women entrepreneurs.
- 6 action plans to further improve services by applying everything learnt and improved during the project.
- 6 entrepreneurship manuals/guides have been developed and are available free of charge in different languages.
- 1 guide with financial resources with more favourable conditions to which they can apply for.
- 8 agreements with key stakeholders.
